Covid 19 transmission for all students	Michelle Mapstone	<ul> <li>Classroom (table, chairs, door handles and any other equipment touched by students) to be cleaned between lessons.</li> <li>Handwashing (using sanitizer) at beginning and end of lesson for all students and tutor.</li> <li>Students to bring their own stationary or to be provided with stationary to use each lesson.</li> <li>No changing of groups – offer online session instead.</li> <li>Students who show symptoms must stay at home and will be offered a session online.</li> <li>If a student displays symptoms, they will be immediately isolated from other students and then parents will be contacted and requested to collect their child from the class immediately.</li> <li>Contamination advice to be followed should there be a confirmed case.</li> <li>Whole centre to be online for 14 days if a student or staff member tests positive.</li> <li>Lessons outdoors when dry and / or doors open to allow good ventilation when the weather allows.</li> <li>Classes a maximum of 5 in a group.</li> <li>Communicate with parents to avoid public transport to attend.</li> <li>Communication between parents and teacher to be via email/ phone call and not at the end of lessons to avoid transmission and to give time for thorough cleaning between lessons.</li> <li>Parents to remain outside the classroom at drop off and pick up and where possible to avoid coming onto site, i.e. for older students.</li> <li>Parents and students to avoid arriving early and to leave promptly at the end of lessons.</li> <li>Face masks to be worn by all students in year 7 and above (or age 11 or above for home educated students).</li> </ul>
